# Members of North Peel Family Health Team

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## FAMILY PHYSICIANS

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- The family physicians
- o assess, diagnose and manage patients' health and wellness
  - o provide counseling and support to patients and their families on a wide range of health and lifestyle issues
  - o advise patients and their families on health care including health promotion and disease/illness/accident prevention
  - o refer patients to specialists when needed

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## NURSE PRACTITIONER

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- The nurse practitioner
- o provides a range of services with a focus on health promotion as well as the assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of health conditions
  - o uses independent, evidence-based practice, education research and critical analysis to manage illness, injuries and disease conditions

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## SOCIAL WORKER

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- The mental health social worker (MHSW)
- o provides assessment, short-term counseling & therapy, patient education and advocacy
  - o provides referrals to community resources and services when needed for patients suffering from depression, anxiety, substance abuse, stress and/or other mental health issues

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## TEAM PSYCHIATRIST

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- The team psychiatrist
- o provides consultation, diagnosis, therapy and treatment of mental health disorders
  - o provides advice/guidance regarding patient care, treatment and interventions
  - o consults and reviews cases with the physician and other health care providers

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## REGISTERED NURSE

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- The registered nurse
- o provides primary nursing care, assessment and health care planning
  - o conducts health histories & physicals and takes biometric measurements
  - o administers immunizations
  - o provides well-baby and family care
  - o triages and monitors patients
  - o provides information with respect to health education, health promotion and disease prevention

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## REGISTERED DIETITIAN

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- The registered dietitian
- o assesses patients to determine physical status, previous weight management & control, compliance with treatment & learning needs
  - o facilitates individual & group teaching sessions for the self-management of diabetes, high cholesterol and high blood pressure as well as weight loss, healthy eating, smoking cessation and other nutrition & health related issues
  - o refers patients to community resources when needed

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## CLINICAL PHARMACIST

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- The clinical pharmacist
- o performs medication reviews and counsels patients who are on multiple medications to assess safety, efficacy, and resolve any drug-related issues
  - o monitors and facilitates prescription renewals
  - o provides drug information and medication therapy education to patients and team members through individual or group sessions

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## SUPPORT STAFF

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- The support staff
- o manages patient appointments, telephones and electronic systems
  - o maintains records
  - o facilitates referrals
  - o provides clerical and administrative support to physicians and allied health team members for optimal communication and office flow
